

Make your own Pom Pom Garland!

Things you'll need:

- Yarn,
- Sharp scissors,
- Pom Pom Maker(s)

Step 1: Choose your colours! You have a selection of yarns in this kit but you can choose any colours you like.

Step 2: Prepare your Pom Pom Maker! These are super easy to use so don't worry. You have a range of sizes. Select two of the same size, match them up and open from the centre



Step 3: Wrap away! Wrap the yarn around one side of the maker. Make sure the plastic is totally covered by pushing down the yarn as you go along. The more layers you create while wrapping, the thicker and fluffier your pom pom will be!



Step 4: Let's go round again! Once the yarn is completely covering the plastic of the maker and you've layered up as many times as you wish, begin wrapping on the other side! Repeat the exact same process on the other side of the maker until the whole thing is completely wrapped up with yarn.

Step 5: Close it up! Fold the maker in half and clip edges together to make a circle!

Step 5: Snip snip! Take your scissors and carefully cut through the top of your wrapped yarn. Make sure you stay in the centre when you do this! Repeat on the other side.



Step 6: Tie the knot Take a new string of yarn and thread through the centre of the maker. Tie the top in a knot and tighten to secure the middle of the pom pom. Remember to keep the tails long enough to use later.



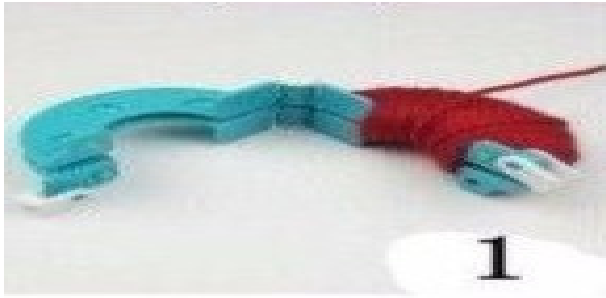
Step 7: Free the pom! Gently open the maker and pull pom pom away.

Step 8: Even poms need haircuts Take your scissors and trim the stragglers on the pom. A good tip is to find the lowest point and cut the rest to match to make it nice and even. The shorter you cut down the pom pom, the neater and puffier it will look! Keep trimming until you reach your desired outcome. Don't trim the centre tails you will need these later

Step 9: Multiply! Go ahead and make as many as you wish to attach to your garland. Remember, as you have a set of different sized makers you can keep them all the same size or mismatch. Let your creativity run free!

Step 10: Get attached Your kit includes satin cord for your garland string. Lay your pom poms out in a line with the amount of space between them you wish them to have when on the garland. Measure and cut the cord to the correct length. Tie the centre yarn from each pom pom around the cord in a double knot to attach them in a row. Alternatively use a needle to pass cord through the centre of the pom pom and sew on to the garland.
